By increasing our current allotment of seven palliative care beds to 15, we can welcome more patients to stay with their loved ones, within their community.

In 2017, **I cared for 116 patients and their families but turned away 250 patients due to lack of space.** Let's make sure that doesn't happen anymore by keeping our end-of-life patients right here in our community. We want to ensure that our patients and their families can spend every precious minute together and not travelling elsewhere for the care they need and deserve.

**A focus on family.**

The design of the hospice residence incorporates the needs of both our patients and their families. There are quiet spaces and outdoor gardens. There will also be a Sacred Space, dedicated for spiritual reflection and prayer that can provide a sense of serenity and peace for patients and their families. Even young children and pets are encouraged to visit, with unrestricted hours.

The end of life journey can be an emotionally and physically draining experience for families and loved ones. Space and time are needed to process and grieve while being assured their loved one receives a supportive, dignified end of life.

**Your donation will help give families the environment they need.**

Family members need space to take care of each other first and to leave the physical caretaking to staff. This allows them to relax back into a supportive family member, rather than carry the burden of a caretaker role.
